



## **A Message from the Executive Dean**

The Touro College of Osteopathic Medicine opened in 2007 across the street from the Apollo Theater in the vibrant Harlem Community of New York City. As of 2018, we have graduated 7 medical school classes, who have gone on to complete residencies in many of the most prestigious hospitals in the United States. We are especially proud to have graduated over 100 underrepresented minority physicians and placed most of our graduates in primary care.

The Middletown Campus of the Touro College of Osteopathic Medicine opened in July of 2014 after a \$25 million renovation to the former Horton Hospital. We have all new state-of-the-art technology including a fully-developed Medical Simulation lab with 19 robotic simulators. We also have an extensive Objective Structured Clinical Examination (“OSCE”) suite with multiple cameras and Electronic Medical Record capability. Our futuristic 3-D Anatomy lab includes virtual anatomy, as well as standard dissection and plastinated specimens taught from a clinical framework.

Since our Grand Opening at the historic Paramount Theatre in downtown Middletown, our medical school campus has won numerous awards from the community. We received recognition from the Orange County Chamber of Commerce, Partners in Progress, as well as the Orange and Sullivan County Community Foundation.

On a recent Committee on Osteopathic College Accreditation (“COCA”) site visit, TouroCOM-Middletown received commendations for the Simulation and OSCE lab, the Anatomy lab, as well as the general learning environment.
